INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the next edition of our Development Ezine. Much has been accomplished since we launched Phase 2 of our *Building on Success* development appeal towards providing your sons with the best possible opportunities to learn, grow and develop into the finest young men that they can be. As we busily prepare for the Easter break, works on our development programme progress each day. Please read on for the latest news.

DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

The construction of the first phase of the Junior School Building's structure is now complete, including external stairs and lift shaft. The bracketry to hold the external façade and the insulation that goes in behind it are all scheduled to be completed by mid-May when the external scaffold will be stripped. The roof has been sealed and the insulation and waterproof membrane are being fitted as we go to print. Prior to completion, a layer of pea gravel will be laid, then the Muga play surface applied. The internal walls are well underway, as are the Mechanical and Electrical works. The windows and doors are 85% installed and the Lift will be fitted in June. Over the Easter break, the new building will be incorporated into the existing Junior School. This is great news as we look forward to completion by summer 2022, ready for the boys to occupy upon their return to school for the new academic term. Once this phase is finalised, we will commence works on the next stage of the Junior School development to replace the existing single storey building to provide a Multi-Purpose Room, a Science Hub with an outdoor garden and a specialist space for Art.

Work on the Senior School STEM building is also progressing. The demolition works of the pool are complete and foundation works for the STEM structure are underway with the steel frame scheduled to be erected in May. The STEM building will be complete in spring 2023. Planning for the new swimming pool is well underway and we will keep you updated as this progresses.
