



## Information and guidelines for supervised evening study 2020-2021

### STUDY TIME MANAGEMENT

Educational Consultants state that: " *In order to succeed, students preparing for the Leaving and Junior Certificate examinations must arrange to set aside **3 hours** (Junior Cert) and **4 hours** (Leaving Cert) per evening (minimum) for study purposes. Apart from homework, daily revision must also be built into the study routine*"

- To sign up for evening study please logon to our website, choose the appropriate option and pay online. Your son's name will then automatically be registered.
- Supervised Study in St. Michael's College offers an ideal opportunity for students to pursue their studies in a controlled, structured environment.
- There is the added advantage of supervised study being a support network for other students.
- The study hall is a place of work, only those who are genuinely serious about their studies should apply.
- A student found to be disruptive will not be allowed to continue study and will be asked to leave the school premises (after having contacted a parent/guardian). If a student persists in being disruptive he could possibly lose his place in study.
- Only a limited number of places are available and we operate strictly on a first-come first-served basis.
- Please note that we function on a pre-paid basis.
- If your son is unable to attend all the sessions due to afterschool activities ie rugby practice, the full amount for the year is still due to be paid.
- Attendance at evening study is recorded on a daily basis.
- Students who discontinue study during the year will be given a partial refund if they leave.
- A student who does not attend on a regular basis or is found to be disruptive will be excluded from study. Parents will be informed.
